Jason's Tooth: A Case Study

WATERTOWN, MA: September 15, 2007— The fascinating case of Jason's Tooth, first published in *Save That Tooth* by Dr. Harold Berk, is featured in the 60th Anniversary issue of the Pulpdent Catalog. The catalog was mailed to 100,000 dentists in North America this fall.

Jason's Tooth could easily serve as a postgraduate course in dentistry. In this case we follow a child who has a replanted immature tooth, complicated by a delay in endodontic treatment and a fistulous tract, followed by root canal therapy, a second traumatic injury to the same tooth, orthodontic treatment, and finally, nonvital bleaching of the replanted tooth for esthetic purposes. All of this took place over a period of 6½ years, and seemingly against all odds, Jason ended up with all of his own teeth and a beautiful smile.

The case study, which includes six radiographs and two photos, outlines the treatment objectives and documents the procedures used to control the abscess, prevent traumatic or idiopathic rejection, stimulate apexification and apexogenesis, and "save that tooth" until Jason becomes a young adult, at which time it is more favorable to consider another treatment plan, such as an implant or bridge, if it should become necessary.
