

## 4 x 5 gm File-Rite



PULPDENT



File-Rite is a 17% EDTA gel that has been buffered to a neutral pH. During instrumentation and debridement of the root canal, File-Rite is an effective calcium binding material for chelating and removing dentin from the canal walls, and it acts as a lubricant to minimize the binding and breaking of files.

## **Directions for Use**

- 1. Always place a rubber dam.
- 2. Remove cap and securely attach a 30 gauge x 1" applicator tip to syringe.
- 3. Dispense File-Rite directly into the canal. For controlled dispensing, hold syringe barrel with fingertips, place plunger in palm, and gently pull back with fingers. File-Rite can also be placed directly on the file or into a dappen dish.
- 4. Instrument the canal. Reapply File-Rite and repeat as necessary until the canal is enlarged and shaped as desired.
- 5. Rinse canal thoroughly.
- 6. Discard needle and place cap back on the syringe. Use a new needle for each patient.

**Note:** Apply disposable barrier sleeves/wraps over multiple-use dental dispensers before use with each patient. For additional information, refer to:
